OPTION 1. Contract Negotiations

Participants will learn how to prepare for and participate in non-state negotiations from being on the negotiating committee, to costing out contract proposals to taking a contact back to the membership for ratification.

OPTION 2. Conducting Labor/Management Meetings

What is a labor/management meeting? What can I as an employee and an officer in the local say and do at a L/M meeting? Learn how to participate in and conduct effective labor/management meetings.

OPTION 3. Internal Organizing/NEO

This class will identify how to internally organize within your local. You will also learn best practices for New Employee Orientations (NEO's) – from formal orientation sessions to steward outreach to ongoing education.

OPTION 4. Challenging Subcontracting

"Outsourcing", "contracting out", "subcontracting," or whatever other name the employer calls it, this class will help you identify ways to monitor when bargaining unit work is subcontracted and to develop alternatives to keep the work in house.

OPTION 5. Community Services

Around the theme of the conference, For Those Who Serve, learn how to create a community services committee, program, and project that your membership will support and volunteer for. Participants will also learn how the PA AFL-CIO Community Services program works as well as ways to get involved.

OPTION 6. NARCAN Training

The opioid epidemic is far from over. This class explores the history of the rise of the use of opioids, the science behind the addiction and the use of NARCAN. Participants will have an opportunity to learn how to properly administer NARCAN at the end of the session.
